## Parent plants

 + Rubin x  Vanda (1984)

## Origin

Strizovice, Czech Republic (Dr. Tupy).

## Growth

Moderately vigorous, weaker growth at a later stage. Somewhat broad growth. Excellent development of twigs and feathers and fairly flat branch arrangement.

## Flowering

Mid to late season, diploid.

Recommended pollinators are: Braeburn, Elstar, Idared, Pinova and Santana.

## Productivity

Early, excellent and regular.

## Harvesting

End of September – beginning of October.

## Appearance

Medium-sized, flat-round fruit, smooth skin. Yellow-orange base colour with orange-red streaked blush.

## Quality

Fruit flesh is yellow, has a fine structure, is fresh, juicy and firm. Taste is good, pleasantly sweetsour and is highly aromatic.

## Storage life

Good storage life; in ULO-storage up to end of April.

## Details:

Topaz is scab resistant (Vf), barely susceptible to mildew, appears to be slightly susceptible to fruit tree cancer. Skin becomes somewhat fatty after cooling.
